

Mainboard Replacement Tool

Use the Tool to write Replacement Digital Product Keys (RDPK) into replaced mainboards.

This tool requires the .NET framework 4.5, which is included as part of Windows 8.

Insert your USB drive and navigate to RDPK.

Start BoardReplacementTool.exe.

Click Browse to select your RDPK file. By default, the file extension is *.bin.

Click Apply to copy the replacement key to the board.

Board Replacement Tool will detect the system type (Notebook/Desktop, 32/64 bit) and take the appropriate steps to write the key.
